Warning Order

1. On 04 May 2024, 709 Toronto Signals RCACC will visit Old Fort York and participate in a tour conducted by facility staff. Then the corps move to Toronto Island for a Nav Trek.
2. Concept of Ops:
 - a. FTX Staff arrive at FYA NLT 0830 hrs 04 May 24, reminder arrive at 0900 hrs
 - b. Required kit will be issued, cadets will be split into two teams, each of which are led by adult staff and senior cadets. Adult team leaders must be first aid qualified.
 - c. The tour of OFY will be signals/artillery focused and will take approx 1.5hrs
 - d. 709 will take the 509 TTC Streetcar from OFY to the Jack Layton Ferry Terminal
 - e. Team one (1) will board the Ward's Island Ferry, team two (2) will board the Hanlan's Point Ferry
 - f. Fresh rations will be eaten for the lunch meal at respective HQ sites
 - g. Nav Trek will commence
 - h. FTX Staff are to be dismissed from FYA NLT 1800 hrs, following the remainder of the Corps at 1730 hrs
3. Orders Group (OGp)
An OGp will commence on 01 May 2024 at 1700 hrs during weekly training at St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic School. All FTX staff are asked to be present. This will allow for any questions or concerns to be raised by FTX Staff.
